The Record 5900 Series ICU/CCU Manual Sliding Door System provides healthcare facilities with simple, easy, attractive access in and out of patient rooms.

Quick and unimpeded patient care is vital in a healthcare facility. To satisfy this requirement, Record 5900 manual sliders may be specified to breakaway into the patient room, or out into the hallway. In addition, Record's exclusive positive latch feature prevents possible entanglement of IV and medical wires that could provide another delay in transporting patients.

ICU door packages are available in multiple configurations that allow total freedom in the design of a patient facility. Select from two, three or four panel options, with or without floor tracks. Other options include three or six panel telescopic designs, also available with and without floor tracks.

Typical ICU latch mechanism's have a small hook bolt protruding from the edge of the door which can often snag clothes or medical wires. With Record's exclusive positive latch the latch occurs in the header eliminating the need for a hook bolt.
